In Fall 1994, Mass Communication was moved from College of Arts and Sciences to the Manship School of Mass Communication.

In Fall 1999, Theatre was moved from College of Arts & Sciences to College of Music & Dramatic Arts.

In Fall 2010 the College of Arts and Sciences was renamed to College of Humanities and Social Sciences. Also, the College of Basic Sciences was renamed to College of Science.

In Fall 2012, the College of Education was merged with School of Social Work, School of Library and Information Sciences, and Human Resource Education, Child and Family Sciences, and Business Education from the College of Agriculture. The newly formed college was renamed Human Sciences and Education.

Additionally, Computer Science moved from the College of Science to the College of Engineering.

Beginning in 2014-15, Baccalaureate degree totals include Post-Baccalaureate certificates.

Academic years as shown include Summer, Fall and Spring semesters.
