

FACULTY SENATE RESOLUTION 84-06

WHEREAS, current University regulations permit students to drop courses without, in most cases, consultation or advisement by anyone knowledgeable of the student's course performance; and

WHEREAS, the student may elect to drop a class without accurate information on his (her) current and future condition in the course; and

WHEREAS, if given the opportunity the instructor could beneficially advise the student on matters pertaining to the student's course performance; and

WHEREAS, the student remaining enrolled in classes would save scarce University resources and avoid needless lengthening of the student's degree program; and

WHEREAS, immediate knowledge of student drop actions would assist the instructor in monitoring class participation,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that all University colleges, schools and divisions not approve a student's drop request in courses number 2999 or below until the instructor has indicated knowledge of the student's request by signing the drop request form. This requirement should apply only after the official date for awarding the W-grade.
